UNIFORM POLICY

Our uniform dress code contributes in a very important way to the overall sense of unity as a school community. The dress code enhances our learning atmosphere, adds a sense of pride and reduces negative competition among the students. All St. James students are expected to wear their uniform in a manner that portrays a positive and modest self-image, personal neatness and cleanliness, and demonstrates an attitude of excellence in performance and achievement. All students are expected to be in the full appropriate uniform each day.

The school's dress code will be maintained throughout the day. Dress code infractions, determined by any faculty or staff member, are subject to disciplinary action at the discretion of the Administration. Infractions include:

- Incomplete uniform or non-uniform including clothing, hair, and jewelry according to criteria below.
- Unwashed, unkempt or inappropriately styled hair according to criteria below.
- Unclean or sloppy dress.

Students will receive a DRESS CODE VIOLATION notice and will be expected to have it signed by parents and returned the following school day.

UNIFORM

Uniforms can be purchased locally at Bahama Joe's Uniform Shop or online at Lands' End. These are the only two places that monogrammed school uniforms may be purchased. Khaki pants, shorts, belts, socks and shoes may be purchased at other stores, but they must follow the uniform guidelines.

GENERALLY:

The school reserves final judgment as to the appropriateness of any dress code item or issue:

- All clothing must be neat and clean
- No frayed, torn, stained or excessively worn items
- Non-uniform sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, etc., may not be worn inside the school
- Jackets and coats may be worn to and from school and during recess
- No long sleeved shirts are to be worn under short sleeved shirts
- Hair must be neat, clean and combed, with a traditional cut
- Boys' hair length may not fall below the top of the shirt collar, nor touch their ears
- Haircuts or styles may not be distracting in any way: no lines, patterns, multi-levels, etc.
- Hair color must be consistent with natural hair color and may not be distracting in any way
- Hair accessories may not be excessive or distracting; colors are limited to the blue + white uniform plaid, navy, red, gray and white
- Makeup, nail polish, lipstick, gloss, tattoos, body piercings, stickers, message buttons, etc. are not acceptable at school
- Jewelry items may consist of simple religious medals, watches and single-stud or small single hoop earrings for girls; the hoop should be of such size that a finger would not fit in it when attached to the ear.
- Heels on girl's shoes are not permitted
- Earrings for boys are not permitted

BOYS:

The boys uniform are for all grade levels - Kindergarten thru 8th grade.

- A. Khaki pants or shorts with belt loops
- B. White or navy blue polo-style shirt w/ St. James logo
- C. White oxford dress shirts with button-down collars, long or short sleeves with logo

- D. Blue+White Plaid tie w/ long-sleeve button-down for dress uniform days
- E. Brown, braided or smooth leather belts must be worn with slacks or shorts
- F. Navy blue outerwear with logos are only permitted in the school: pull-over sweater, sweater vest, pull-over fleece and zip-up fleece
- G. Crew length socks must be navy blue or white with slacks, navy blue or white with shorts - no letters or logos allowed on socks, no low cut athletic styles are permitted
- H. Brown dress shoes, slip on or with brown laces and skid-free soles; examples: Bucks, Wallabees - no athletic, hiking or boot styles are permitted. Boat shoes permitted for 3rd-8th grade and only solid dark or light brown - no prints or other colors.

GIRLS:

The girls uniform changes slightly between the grade levels, please note the differences.

- A. Blue + White Plaid required for all grades but in different styles:
 - K - 3rd Grade: Jumper or Skort
 - 4th - 5th Grade: Skort or Skirt
 - 6th - 8th Grade: Skirt
- B. White polo shirts (girls or boys cut) with logo can be worn with shorts or skirts (All Grades)
- C. White Peter Pan color button-down shirt (long or short sleeved) with logo are worn with jumpers (K-3rd)
- D. White Oxford button-down shirts (long or short sleeved) with logo are worn with skirts or skirts (All Grades)
- E. Dress Uniform Days - must wear white oxford button-down with skirts or skorts, including button tie
- F. Jumper, skort and skirt length must be no more than 2 inches above the knee
- G. Navy blue, gray or white shorts or the uniform PE shorts **must** be worn under jumper and skirt
- H. Navy blue outerwear with logos are only permitted in the school: cardigan sweater, pull-over sweater, sweater vest, pull-over fleece and zip-up fleece
- I. Navy blue or white knee socks (pulled up) or crew length white socks - no letters or logos allowed on socks, no low cut athletic styles are permitted

- J. Navy blue tights may be worn in the winter
- K. Brown dress shoes with skid-free soles; examples: Mary Janes, Bucks, Wallabees - no athletic, heels or boot styles are permitted. Boat shoes permitted for 3rd-8th grade and only solid dark or light brown - no prints or other colors.
- L. Hair accessories must be non-detracting and simple and in the school plaid or school colors - navy blue, white, gray and red

P.E. Uniform

PE uniforms must be purchased through Bahama Joe's in Savannah and must have the Charger logo. Any Chargers shirt purchased through the school may also be worn for P.E. classes.
